

Signed in 2015 by 193 countries 17 goals 169 targets 232 indicators

Follow-up to Millennium Development Goals

- TARGET: Integrate climate change measures into national policies, strategies and planning
- **INDICATOR:** Number of countries that have communicated the establishment or operationalization of an integrated policy/strategy/plan
- TARGET: Promote mechanisms for raising capacity for effective climate change-related planning and management

- TARGET: Improve the regulation and monitoring of global financial markets and institutions and strengthen the implementation of such regulations
- **INDICATOR:** Financial Soundness Indicators (IMF)



- STRONG: 193 country leaders, quantified goals-targets-indicators, mid-term 15 years
- UNIVERSAL: all countries have to deal all topics
- INDIVISABLE & INTERLINKED: coherency, no cherry picking, priority setting in context
- MULTI-STAKEHOLDER: business, finance, civil society, knowledge, youth, government



Boost SDG activities:

- from pioneers to leaders, now the peloton
- from sustainability officers to CEOs and politicians, now the operational level
- from philanthropy & subsidy to procurement, now the mainstream

SDGs tools:

- Return, Risks & Impact; Strategy, KPIs, Reporting
- Compulsory SDG-test of new regulation and on financial support



PROCESS

- Mapping: inventories of what is already happening by ministries, subnational governments, business, finance, science, NGOs in 2016 and later years.
- Measuring: statistical facts with the help of indicators of UN, Eurostat, Dutch Statistics, local in the years 2016, 2018 and 2019.
- Gapping: what needs to be done until 2030? Decisions by CEOs and Politicians in their regular workflow.



ORGANISATION:

General: Each party keeps its own responsibility, people and money.

- Horizontal Coordination: Minister of Foreign Affairs (MFA), High Level
 Officer (HLO), Focal Points at Ministries and Stakeholders
- Vertical Coordination: HLO with coordinators of 17 SDG Alliances of existing platforms, coalitions, movements, etc. etc. etc.
- Networking: SDG Charter (financed by MFA) with 500 members and stakeholder representatives for the bottom-up process.

MEASURING PROGRESS

- Accuracy and frequency of measuring is important
- Reporting progress on indicators shouldn't lead to additional administrative (paper) burdens
- Currently looking into using Standard Business Reporting (SBR) & XBRL to report on SDGs and other sustainability measures.
